**SPIRIT WEEK GUIDELINES**

The following clothing is permitted:

- \*Students do not have to be in uniform
- \*Students can wear NO MORE THAN 3 pieces of flair
- \*Pants should not be too tight or too loose
- \*If skirts are worn, they must be to the knee

Students must meet the following criteria to participate:

- \*\$25 during paycheck week ending 10/20/17 that \*Scholar must not be on NEC list or RISE
- \*Students that violate the rules will not be able to participate for the rest of the week

The following clothing is NOT permitted:

- \*Clothing with inappropriate writing or pictures
- \*Sleeveless shirts or shirts with spaghetti straps
- \*No shorts above knee or boxers
- \*No sagging pants (pants should be at waist)
- \*No house shoes or slippers
- \*No torn jeans or torn clothing
- \*No gang symbols, bandanas or other headwear covers the face
- \*No glasses unless they're prescription
- \*No jackets during class
