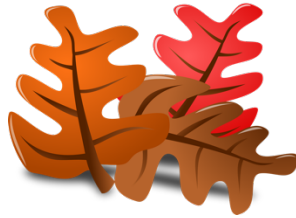
## Academic Update

## Q1 Parent Academic Conversation Guide and Notes Page

Questions you might want to ask staff:

- Does my child seem to like school and get along with classmates?
- Have you noticed any changes in my child over the year?
- Is my child performing at, above, or below grade-level?
- What are my child's strengths in class? How does my child need to grow?
- How can we work together to help my child be the best they can be?

Questions you might be asked by staff:

- Did you receive the report card that went home last Monday?
- How are you feeling about this school year? How is your student feeling?
- How often do you talk about school expectations with your student?
- What goals do you share with your student when it comes to grades?
- What gets your student excited about school?
- What does your student want to be when they grow up?
- How can we better help your student succeed in school?

Factors contributing to your student's academic performance: these are good questions to ask!

"During the past quarter, did my scholar..."

complete and turn in **homework** assignments?

complete and turn in **class work** assignments?

**pay full attention** to classroom activities?

**behave** in a manner that allows for learning?

attend regularly and arrive to school **on time**?

consistently pass **tests/quizzes**?

come to class **prepared** with basic supplies and materials?

work at or above grade level as shown on **benchmark and interim assessments**?
